OFFICIAL RULES (1 January – 31 May 2010)

Individual Recruiting (National Level)

Incentives:

- The individual who recruits the most new members receives a Life Membership or a free registration, to include a guest, to this year's Forum in Washington, DC.
- Second place will receive a free Southwest Airlines Ticket to the destination of choice in the Continental United States.
- Third place will receive a Kindle Reader.

Credits:

- One credit for each new member in the A-35, Military A-35, Government A-35, and Student Categories. No other categories count for individual recruiting credit.
- Individual credits for new members will be awarded based on the sponsor shown on the membership application form. There will be no individual credits awarded for membership renewals.
- Sponsors must be NDTA members. If the name of the sponsor is not shown on the membership application form, no credit will be awarded to an individual.
- A "New" member is a person who has not been an NDTA member within the 12 months prior to enrollment. All credits will be awarded based on NDTA Headquarters records.

Chapter Recruiting (National Level)

Incentives:

- The three chapters in each category, which have accumulated the highest number of credits, will receive a \$500 cash award. (Chapters with 100 or less members – Category I; Chapters with 101-200 members – Category II; Chapters with 201 or more members – Category III)

Credits:

- One credit for each renewal (Regular, Government, Military, A-35 or Student)
- One credit for each new member (Regular, Government, Military, A-35, Life, or Student)

***Note:** The results of this membership drive do not affect the annual competition for the Colonel Norbert Grabowski Recruiting Awards, which has been going on since 1 July 2009 and will conclude on 30 June 2010. However, winners of the **Next Generation** Recruiting Drive will receive recognition at the Forum in Washington, DC, along with the winners of the Grabowski awards.*

Twofer (National Level)

- Sign up a new paying member in any category (Regular, Military, Government Civilian, A-35, Retired, Student, or Life) and match it with another new member in any category (except Life), and that second new member gets a free one-year membership.
- Submit one check as payment to NDTA Headquarters in Alexandria VA.
- The applications must be stapled and submitted together with each clearly marked as a "Twofer."

- Renewals do not count - both the paying and the free membership must be new members.
